The programme we presented last year, **Lean Business Excellence - Malta 2011** (details on www.scodanibbio.com/malta2011/) was a remarkable success: this was the first Lean programme of this scale ever to be launched on the islands to date.

Some participating organisations reinforced or re-vitalised their lean practices. A few others went afresh into the lean road, launching "in-house" lean initiatives company-wide.

In the meantime the global situation has deteriorated even further: economically, financially and politically, to say the least.
